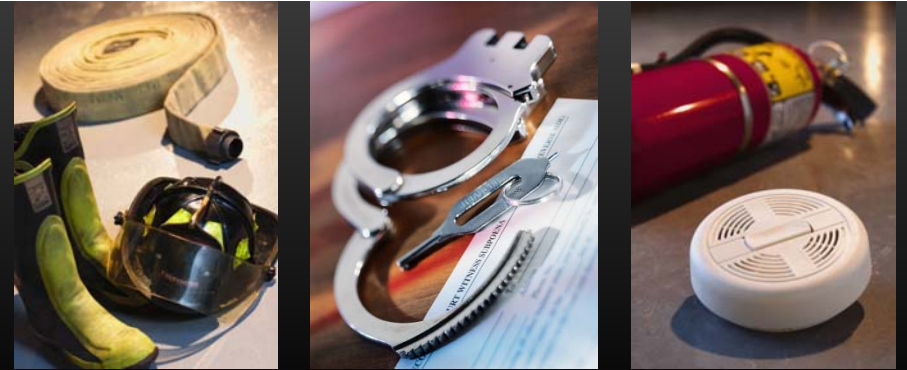


FIRE SALES TAX RENEWAL

2012 Citizen Survey Results:

- Fire and police services top 4 highest rated services by businesses. Fire also topped the resident list.
- Crime and safety highest priority second only to economic development.
- Drugs received highest "major" attention assessment (57%) followed by run-down buildings (50%) and run-down homes (42%).

Fire Tax Renewal – November 2014 - 2035

Keep the Tax the Same
Keep Equipment/Facilities Up-to-Date
Keep Cape Safe

Fleet (\$600,000/Year)

- Police vehicles every 7-10 years \$215,000/Year
- Fire trucks, other fleet every 10-15 years \$385,000/Year

Facilities (\$600,000/Year)

- Police Station \$265,000/Year
- Fire Stations (#1, #2, and #4) \$335,000/Year

TOTAL \$1,200,000/Year

Fire Tax - 2004-2014

Promised and Delivered

- Fire Station #3
- Emergency Operations Center (EOC)
- Vehicles
- Safety Gear
- Firearms
- 911 / Communications

Other Public Safety Capital Revenue Sources

Casino Revenue Commitment

- Innovation Funds – Radio Interoperability \$610,000 (2 years)
- Capital Funds – EOC Security Addition \$100,000
- Police Station (if needed) \$3,000,000

Police Station Funding Sources

- Restaurant Tax \$4,200,000
- Fire Tax \$4,000,000
- Casino Funds \$2,800,000
- \$11,000,000**

Consequences of Fire Tax Failure:

- Public Safety Service erodes over time
 - Equipment is not replaced
 - Operational budgets may be compromised to replace equipment
- Outdated equipment and training leads to higher turnover
